Questions

1. Page 2 asks for an original and three (2) copies. Are two copies ok?

Yes 2 copies will be acceptable.

2. Why will no alternate bids be accepted if you are asking for a reconditioned unit in the first place? No exceptions.

I consider an alternate bid to be something that does not resemble what we have out lined. If you bid a Dodge chassis this would be considered an alternate bid.

3. Page 4- This specification is an earlier version of triple K-A-1822F, and do not comply with the most current version of the federal ambulance guidelines, referred to a change notice 8. So do you not want to comply with the latest revision?

This must have been an oversight on my part. Yes we want to comply with the latest standard

4. P.17 requires sign gold leaf which is really expensive and the picture I took of the truck in your bay has printed gold leaf design which is much less expensive. Are you wanting to upgrade to sign gold leaf?

An oversight on my part again. We do not want to upgrade.

5. I would like to offer an alternate bid with drawings and specifications that shows exactly what is being offered.

A bid that represents an ambulance that best meets our needs and budget is what we are looking for. In the opening statement of the document it states we were using the specifications from our last purchase. No wording within the document should be considered making this an exclusive document to one specific manufacturer. The last set of specifications was used only to get a unit that closely resembles the current units in service as possible.

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
